Quickly probes cognitive, linguistic, and communicative abilities. Ideal first assessment post-coma because it is brief and efficient. Can be given in multiple short sessions. Sensitive to small performance changes, useful for tracking recovery patterns during spontaneous recovery. Results used in advising other team members of the best approaches for communication and treatment.
